LEARNING OBJECTIVES: What information and/or skill will you learn in this study?

- **To Develop** an understanding of the accountability of God's leaders to exhibit godly emotions in decision making.
- **To Learn** that being the daughter of a King is a tangible choice to act according to the royal family's code of behavior as spelt out in the Bible or as exemplified by Bible characters who are our faith siblings.
- **To Discipline** one's responses to disappointments and setbacks by choosing to process the pain of loneliness, rejection and fear according to the royal family code of behavior.
- **To Cultivate** a heart for the community and authentic friendships with other women with leadership responsibilities in the city.
- **To Complete** a project that takes into consideration the student's spiritual journey to-date and helps her to reach the next level in ministry or a better understanding of God's purpose for her.

REQUIRED MATERIAL

REQUIREMENTS/POLICIES

- **Weekly Reading/Homework Assignments** - Four (4) readings and accompanying homework assignments; one for each module week.
- **Class Participation** – The student is expected to take accurate lecture notes during group sessions and are encouraged to fully participate in small group discussions by sharing openly, yet discreetly with group members as the Spirit of God leads.
- **Final Exam** – Each Module will conclude with a final exam; the student is required to pass the final exam with a score of 70% or better
- **Re-teaching** – The student will show understanding of Institute material for each module by sharing the module material with at least one (1) or more individuals of their choice.
- **Attendance** – A total of two (2) absences are permitted during the twelve (12) weeks of modules. No more than one absence is permitted in a module.
- **One on One Spiritual Coaching** – After completing two modules the student will meet individually with Anita Carman (or designated staff) to assess where she is in her spiritual journey. A personal project will be crafted to help each student reach their next level of service or spiritual development.
- **Duration** - The Leadership Certificate is designed so that the student can complete all modules in one (1) calendar year. However, a student may take up to a period of two (2) years to meet all requirements
